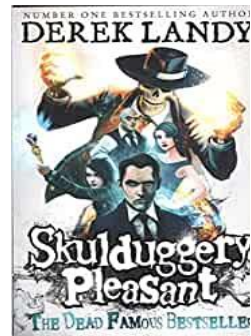

We will learn how the lungs and heart work and how this is affected when we exercise.

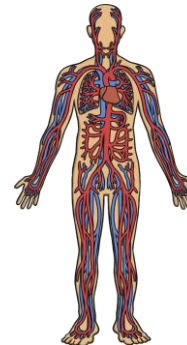

Outdoor Adventurous Activities
